**The «Russian Academy of Architecture and Construction Sciences» (RAACS or, transliterating the Russian acronym, RAASN) (Российская академия архитектуры и строительных наук, РААСН) is the official academy of the Russian Federation specializing in architecture and construction, notably of urban buildings.**

***It was established by a decree of the President of the Russian Federation on March 26, 1992; its precursors were the Academy of Architecture of the USSR (1934 - 1956) and the Academy of Construction and Architecture of the USSR (1956 - 1964). It has 60 full members (academics), 115 corresponding members, 64 honorary members, and 75 foreign members from 25 countries. The Academy is headquartered in Moscow and it has five regional divisions: Saint Petersburg, Volga, Uralian, Siberian, and Southern. Nowadays, since 2014, the president is Aleksandr Viktorovich Kuzmin.***
